Permanent possession of this trophy was given to the University of Notre Dame at close of the 1930 season for the best record during the period and as a three-time yearly winner. In 1924, Mr. Jack F. Rissman of Chicago originated this trophy in the hope that such an award and recognition would provide stimulus for further public understanding of the importance of Intercollegiate football competition. Selection of the yearly and permanent possessor of the trophy was under the Frank G. Dickinson Football Rating System.
