HAPPY EASTER!

Sorin Chapel Closed - Wednesday Noon to Monday.

The rubrics do not permit the use of the hall chapels during the last three days of Holy Week. On Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, the services will be held only in the church. Holy Communion will not be distributed outside of Mass. Note below ~~the hours of services~~. Holy Communion is not distributed at all on Good Friday, except to the dying.

Holy Week Services.

Masses: Thursday, 7:00 a.m.
Saturday, 7:30 a.m. (This Mass is preceded by the blessings - at 6:00 a.m.)

Other services:

Tenebrae. - Matins and Lauds for the following day are sung at 7:30 p.m. on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday.

Mass of the Presanctified. - Good Friday morning at 8:00.

Way of the Cross. - Friday at 3:00 p.m. It is followed by Benediction with the relic of the True Cross.

Nocturnal Adoration. - Watch is kept before the Blessed Sacrament from the Mass of Holy Thursday until the service of Good Friday morning.

Easter Sunday Masses.

There are no student Masses next Sunday, but students are expected to attend the parish Masses, which will be at 6:00 (in the basement chapel) and at 8:00 and 10:30 (in the church).

Knute Rockne's Anniversary.

The day after your return from the Easter vacation there will be a solemn anniversary Mass sung by the President for the repose of the soul of Knute Rockne. You are given advance notice of this event so that you will return to school prepared to offer Holy Communion on Thursday morning in union with the intentions of the celebrant.

Vacation Dances.

This is a warning. If there are any complaints about conduct at dances given by Notre Dame clubs during the holidays, they will be investigated. If the investigation proves that the complaints are justified, the Prefect of Religion will suggest to the administration that the social privileges of the clubs in question be withdrawn. If social affairs given in the name of the University of Our Lady cannot succeed without the patronage of those who care nothing for the honor of Our Lady, they have no reason for existence.
