Dignity and power, in heaven and on earth, she is; but human, and to be imitated.

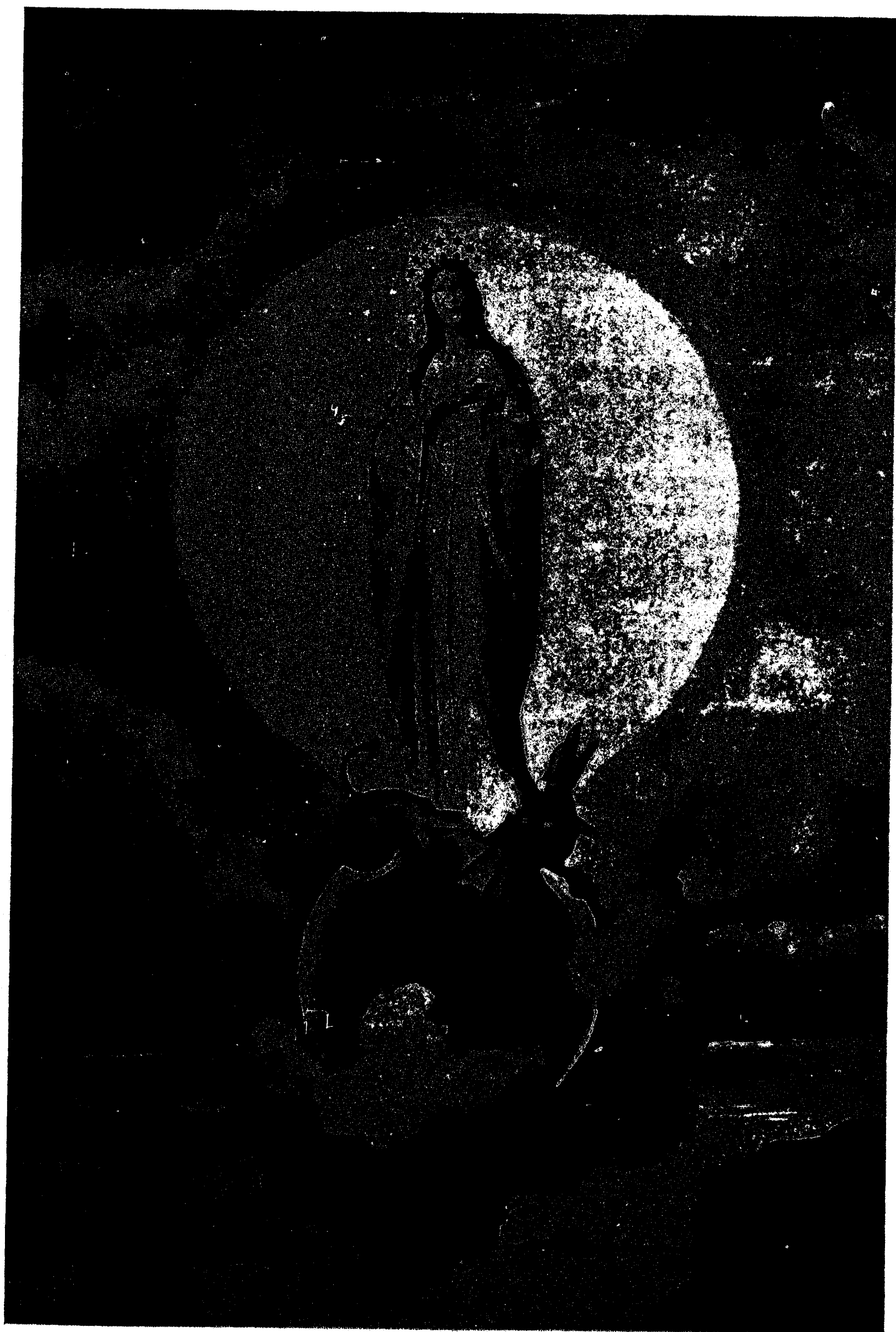
Mary's dress is white to recall her stainless purity. Her mantle is blue that we may not forget her humility.
