In your examination of conscience be honest and deliberate. Get the number and kinds of the mortal sins if there are any. Don't try to cover every angle and every circumstance of slight offenses and venial sins. After the examination of conscience make an act of contrition. Then confess your sins humbly, neither exaggerating nor excusing them. After confession say your penance as soon as possible. Then go in peace.
