
PENNY-A-DAY-IN-LENT FOR THE BULLETIN CHARITIES


REMEMBER:

- 1. The spirit behind PENNY-A-DAY is love for OUR LORD in the hearts of HIS NEEDIEST BRETHREN. "Whatsoever you do to the least of these, you do to Me."
- 2. By your generosity you share in the missionary labors of Priests, Brothers, Sisters and lay-catechists working, with grace, to save souls for CHRIST. Your pennies multiply cells for THE MYSTICAL BODY OF CHRIST.
- 3. The frank purpose of choosing LENT for the Penny-a-day campaign is to capitalize, for the missions, on the prevalent spirit of self-denial. Notice the word: SELF-DENIAL. The idea isn't to send home for a bigger budget, or to shell out a few coins grudgingly or with a sense of half-compulsion. It's TO SACRIFICE; to give up this candy or coke, that show or that smoke and to give the pennies thus saved to OUR LORD in His Negro poor or His Mexican destitutes or His aboriginal Bengali tribesmen. Penny-a-day WITHOUT THIS SPIRIT OF SELF-DEPRIVATION will fail of its principal aim as far as you are concerned.
- 4. So, give in a way that hurts; give for Christ; and ask your recording Guardian Angel to check off some of the debt due to your sins of the past.
