Does having Christ in your midst mean anything to you? It did to Magdalen - she fell at the feet of Christ and He forgave her sins and restored her purity. It did to the man born blind - Christ gave him sight. It did to the Apostles - "Lord, to whom shall we go. You have the words of eternal life."

When Christ walked the streets of Palestine, the people left their homes and their work when they heard that He was approaching their town. Last Sunday the Gospel told you of the paralytic whose pals could not reach Christ because of the crowds and so they tore a hole in the roof of the house and let the sick man down through it into the presence of the Master, who told him to take up his bed and walk.

Christ tells us that we need him: "Without me you can do nothing". Bring your worries to the Master, and your doubts, your sins and your soul. He will help you.

Christ stopped a raging storm and saved the Apostles. He can stop this war. But you must go to him on your knees like the frightened Apostles: "Lord, save us, lest we perish".

Come to Christ not only during your half-hour periods of adoration, but frequently during the day, even for just a minute between classes, and on your way to the Roc.
