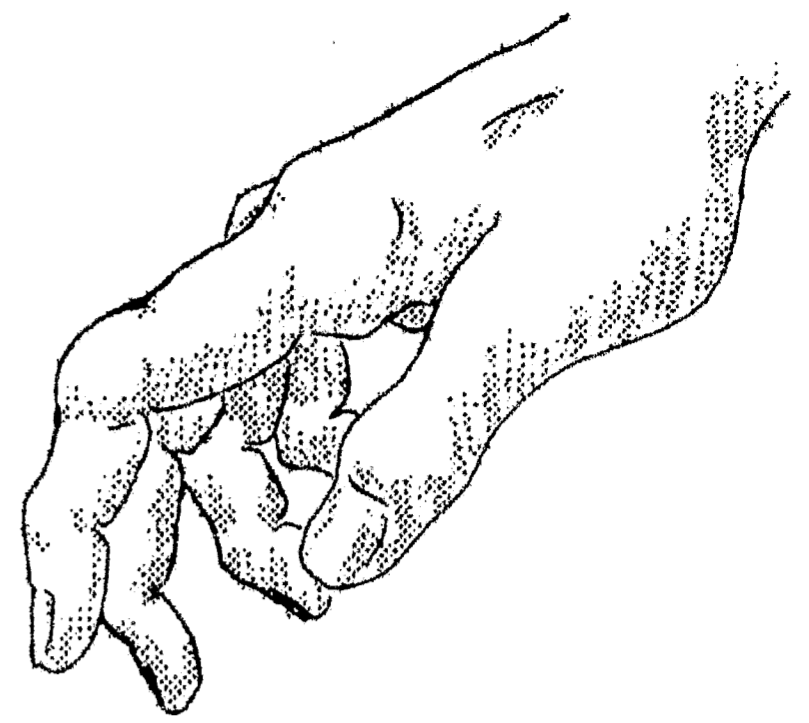

Generous students will not forget their deceased parents, relatives and friends during November. They will start this period of prayer and sacrifice Monday, All Souls Day, by attending three Masses. On this day every priest has the privilege of offering three Masses. Consult your rector for the time of Mass in your hall.

Make Visits And Send Souls To Heaven.

Every time you visit your hall chapel or the Church and say 6 Our Fathers, 6 Hail Marys and 6 Glory Be To The Fathers for the intention of the Holy Father, you gain a plenary indulgence for a soul in Purgatory. This special indulgence can be gained from Sunday noon (Nov. 1) until Monday midnight (Nov. 2).

Novena Devotions.

During the Novena for the Poor Souls there will be Benediction and Rosary after supper in the Church at 7:00. Besides the intrinsic value of your prayer at these devotions, the Rosary said before the Blessed Sacrament merits a plenary indulgence. You may transfer this indulgence to some Poor Soul.
