

Love of Our Lord in the Eucharist will lead you to make a half hour period or two of Adoration in the Church on the Anniversary Day of the institution of the Mass and Holy Communion. Go to Christ on this day and thank Him for the rich blessings He has granted you in the Sacrament of His Love.

Think . . . Pray . . . Listen

Adoration becomes easy and fruitful if you first of all THINK. Recall where you are and in whose presence you are kneeling. Our Lord is on the altar, His lovable person concealed from your eyes by the appearance of Bread. Remember that if the accidents of bread dropped away, you would see the Living Christ with His love, mercy power and kindness. Before you is the Christ who forgave Peter, Magdalen, the Good Thief, who cured the sick, consoled the woman of Naim sorrowing over the death of her only son.

PRAY Put yourself last. The object of your prayer should be: the bodies and souls of the Service men and the war victims, especially the thirty six N.D. men who have died in the Service; the Missing, the Captured. Petition Christ for peace and for consolation for your parents who are worrying about your future. Ask Our Saviour to give you his thoughts about life, womanhood, death, sin, charity towards others.

LISTEN. Give Christ a chance to suggestions to make to you, the Host will come the answer to No man ever became great who fired to action. Courageous, solitude and listen. The fire.
