Killed in Action: Lieut. Billy Adams, ex '42.

Billy was previously reported missing in action. Recently the government notified his mother that a report received from the German government through the International Red Cross stated that Lieut. Adams was killed in action June 13, 1943, in the European area. Lieut. Adams, pilot of a four-engined bomber, failed to return to England June 13 from a raid on the German naval bases of Bremen and Kiel. Billy is our 70th Gold Star.
