And when a kid will say, 'Sir, I don't wear lace on my drawers, I can beat hell out of you, and you're damn right I pray,' I apologize to him, and he is a man in our group. Of course it takes me another hour to explain to him what I've been doing all day, but after that it's all right, and we are big pals."
