A G.I. with the occupation forces in Germany writes this interesting paragraph in a letter to a priest on the campus: "In victory or defeat N.D. is still the sidewalk man's team. About a month ago while walking along a street here in Germany on a Sunday morning, a Kraut bicyclist pulled up along side of us. We ignored him, as we expected his inquiry would be for a cigarette or gum. But he awakened our interest sharply with: 'How did Notre Dame come out against Illinois?'"
