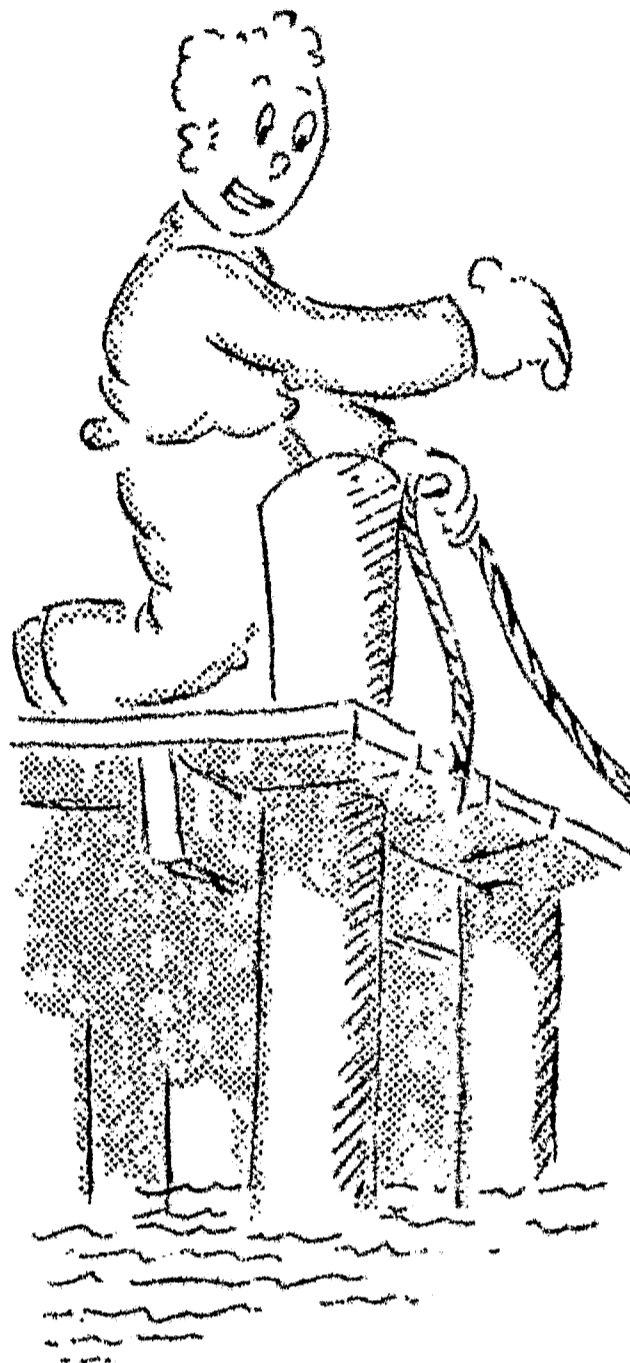


Tonight: the Mission
