Lenten Dispensation.

All students are dispensed from the law of fasting during Lent.

Abstinence (no meat) must be kept on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and the forenoon

of Holy Saturday, and on all Fridays. On all other days meat may be taken three times a day, even on Embers Days.

Others dispensed, besides the students, are the wives of students, professors and their families and employees and their families.

The privilege is effective whether food is taken on or off campus.

No one may partake of this privilege unless he works seriously at his studies or other duties, and he must substitute, according to the letter from the Bishop, "other forms of penitential works, such as attendance at public Lenten devotions or weekday Mass, and the practice of voluntary self-denial or some sort, such as abstention from alcholic beverages or too worldly amusements."
