More About Marriage Documents

A letter stating that the banns have been or will be published must be included among the marriage papers. The banns are a public announcement of the marriage made in the parish church of both the bride-to-be and the groom. The Church law requires three announcements of the marriage. These are usually made on the three Sundays preceding the marriage, either from the pulpit at one of the principal Masses of the day or printed in the parish newspheet.

The parties themselves must see that their pastors announce the banns. The letter of request should give the names of both parties, their parishes and the date and place of the intended marriage. When all three banns cannot be announced because of the shortness of time, a dispensation must be secured from the Bish-p (The Pastor will procure it). The letter of dispensation must be included among the documents.

The transfer of a marriage from the parish of the bride to another parish in the same town or to a church out of town may be done only with the permission of the pastor of the bride. This permission should be obtained in writing before the marriage request is made of another parish. (Note: Students and alumni of Notre Dame who desire to be married on the campus must first obtain the permission of the bride's pastor, and then seek the permission of the University through the Vice-President presenting the pastor's letter of approval when making the request.)
