Thursday: Ascension Thursday -- a Holy Day of Obligation. All Masses will be in Sacred Heart Church as on Sunday.

Friday: Confessions and Communion until 10:00 a.m. in Dillon Chapel. Confessions Friday evening, 6:00 until 8:00 in Dillon chapel only.

No Novena Services on Friday evening.

Saturday: Confessions and Communion until 10:00 only in Dillon chapel. Drop in early, since you have the Class Visit at 9:00, followed by Class Day Exercises at 10:00.

Saturday afternoon -- Confessions in Sacred Heart Church from 4:00 until 5:00. No Saturday evening confessions in Dillon chapel.

Sunday
Morning: Remember: there will be no distribution of Communion
at the Mass in the stadium.

Accordingly, for your convenience -- and for the convenience of your guests -- Holy Communion will be distributed in Dillon Hall Chapel, at 10-minute intervals, from 7:00 a.m. until 8:45 a.m.

The Mass in the stadium begins at 9:00 a.m.

At the Church: Masses in Sacred Heart Church at 7,8,9,10:15, 11:30.

In case of rain: The Mass scheduled for the stadium (at 9:00) will be transferred to the Drill Hall. The overflow crowd will be directed to a Mass in the Gymnasium at the same hour.

Monday morning: Confessions and Communion in Dillon Chapel until 9:30.

After Monday: Daily Mass in Dillon Chapel at 7:15 only.
