If Holy Communion is received by the faithful, all recite the Confiteor (see prayers at the beginning of Mass) after which the priest says:

- C. Dómine, non sum dignus—ut intres sub tectum meum sed tantum dic verbo—et sanábitur ánima mea. (three times)
