Friday, June 3--

First Friday of the Month. Masses in Dillon: 6:30, 7:00, 7:30, 8:00, 8:30. Masses in Sacred Heart Church: 9:30, 10:30, 11:30, and 5:10. Confessions at all the Masses. No Novena services on Friday evening. Confessions in Dillon from 7:00 until 10:00 P.M. Push the buzzer in the vestibule.

Saturday, June 4--

First Saturday of the Month. Masses in Dillon: 6:30, 7:00, 7:30, 8:00, 8:30. Last visit to Sacred Heart Church (for seniors only): 9:00 A.M. Masses in Sacred Heart Church: 9:30 (in the Crypt), 10:30 (upper church), 11:30 (upper church). Confessions in Sacred Heart church at all the Masses and in the evening from 6:00 until 8:30.

Sunday, June 5--

Masses in Sacred Heart church: 6:00, 7:00, 8:00, 9:00, 10:00, 11:00, and 12:15. The Baccalaureate Mass will be at 9:00, on the Mall. Holy Communion will not be distributed at the Baccalaureate Mass. (HOLY COMMUNION WILL BE DISTRIBUTED IN DILLON CHAPEL FROM 7:00 until 8:30, AT TEN MINUTE INTERVALS.)

● TODAY, TOMORROW, AND WEDNESDAY are known as Rogation Days--days of prayer for God's blessing on our hearts and homes and fields. It's a good time for city dwellers to recall how dependent we are on country, gardeners, and farmers for the "fruits of the earth". These days should also be a time of preparation for the celebration of the Lord's Ascension. This feast we'll keep on Thursday marks the beginning of Our Lord's heavenly Priesthood at the right hand of the Father, whence He directs His Church through His Holy Spirit, preparing His redeemed members for final participation in His Divinity.

● THE SCHEDULE OF MASSES in Sacred Heart church and Keenan-Stanford chapel on Ascension Thursday will be the same as on Sunday. Remember that Thursday is a Holy day of obligation.
