FIRST FRIDAY

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is a tradition at Notre Dame on the First Friday of each month. The Blessed Sacrament is exposed on the Bernini altar of the Lady Chapel after the 11:30 Mass, and the adoration period concludes with the consecration to the Sacred Heart and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at 4:45.

Your period of adoration will seem more solemn if you vest in a cassock and surplice, found in the sacristy off the west transcept. But the important thing is to spend a period of adoration -- try to make it at least half an hour -- talking to Our Lord as a Friend and Confidant. You will be kneeling in the Presence of Him Who said: "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will refresh you." (Matt. 11:28)





The Novena for Parents began today. If you forgot this morning -- or overslept -- there is still opportunity to begin your nine Masses and Communions at the 5:10 Mass. You may even begin tomorrow and still obtain for your parents a share in the Novena of Masses being said.
