CIRCULAR LETTER No. 65

Notre Dame, September 8, 1875.

REV. FATHERS AND BELOVED CHILDREN IN JESUS CHRIST:

This morning, at 5.30, SISTER M. ALFREDA died in the infirmary at St. Mary's, after a long and painful sickness, and strengthened with the Sacraments and all the consolations of our Holy Faith. Her name in the world was Mary Lindner; she was born in 1820, received the holy Habit in 1858, and made her Profession in 1862. She had been lingering for some years, and although suffering much—of late, intensely—she never uttered a complaint. May she now rest in peace!

The burial service will take place to-morrow, at 6 a. m., in the Convent Chapel.
