The Reverend Theodore M. Hesburgh, C.S.C., President of the University of Notre Dame, reiterated this morning the fact that the University is non-partisan in this and other campaigns. The pronouncement was occasioned by a statement issued yesterday by some Notre Dame faculty members endorsing one of the presidential candidates. Father Hesburgh said that the endorsement of this group, representing about one-tenth of Notre Dame's faculty, was made without the knowledge or endorsement of University officials, and in no way affects the University's non-partisan position.

Both presidential candidates have visited Notre Dame in recent weeks at Father Hesburgh's invitation to address the faculty and student body on the crucial moral and spiritual issues of the present campaign.
