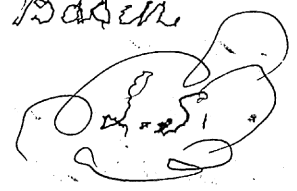

Steph^r Theodore Badin who subscribed and acknowledged the foregoing power of Attorney to be his act and deed for the purpose therein mentioned and thereby breaking all other powers of Attorney which he may have given for the same end, especially the one to Rev Julian Benoit whose actings & doings in the same, are hereby annulled as being repugnant to the express terms and stipulations of the donation as aforesaid. Know all men by these presents that I Stephen Theodore Badin of the County of Jefferson and State of Kentucky have made nominated & appointed and by these presents do make nominate and appoint the Rev^d John Quinn of the same County & State my true & lawful Attorney for me & in my name and for my use & benefit to ask¹, recover³, demand² & receive⁴ of & from Rev^d Edward F. Sorin of Notre Dame du Lac St Joseph Co. Indiana all such sums of money claims and demands whatsoever which are now due and owing to me, or which may hereafter become due and owing unto me the said Stephen Theodore Badin by & from the said Edward F. Sorin according to the terms of my donation as acknowledged by said Sorin and duly recorded, and to have use & take all lawful ways and means in my name or otherwise for the recovery thereof, and acquittances, or other sufficient discharges for the same for me and in my name to make seal and deliver, and to do all lawful acts and things whatsoever, Concerning the premises is fully and in every respect as I myself might or could do were I personally present; ratifying & confirming & by these presents allowing whatsoever my said attorney shall in my name lawfully do in & about the premises by virtue of these presents.
