As some misunderstanding, concerning accounts and other business transactions, has been in existence for several months, between Very Rev. Stephen C. Rudin and Very Rev. Edward Gorin Superior of the Community of Notre Dame Du Lac; which misunderstanding still continued a few days past, though the parties had made several attempts at a final settlement; the Subscriber, having received full power of attorney from the Very Rev. Stephen C. Rudin, merely for want of recollection, about dates &c. &c., had presented claims which were not founded, and that the accounts of Very Rev. Edward Gorin have been found substantially correct, and that Rudin remains indebted to L.
