My Dear Father Lovin

There is a young man in this city by the name of Callaghan who is very desirous of being a Priest. The A.B.P. will not receive him. He has no means of supporting himself while at the Seminary - Could you employ him in any way as teacher - he is a good Mathematician and considerably advanced in his studies. In such a way as to give him a chance? He is about 19. - He taught school for me several months with great assiduity, & I believe with considerable success. Mr Goldsberry knows him. Tell Mr Goldsberry that Mrs Dixon wants to know when he will return - I am very sorry her life Cincinnati but very glad he went to you.
