with you this summer. I have no doubt  
your examination is now well attended  
many visitors and had I a chance it  
would afford me pleasure to be among  
them.

I have remained myself  
as well as possible to the death of Emily  
the boy was as promising a child as family  
could ask. and we must submit to his  
loss as one of those inevitable losses  
of God beyond our powers of comprehension.  
I wish you would be kind enough to say  
to Miss Angier that I promised my  
Sherman to write her an explanation of  
my leaving Mississi as the labor is  
circumst. When I have ~~written~~ as  
a post my memory fails to recall but  
it was my act. I wanted Mississi

at School constantly. She is very forward  
for her years, and should not lose a  
day to begin the knowledge which she  
should possess as distinctly. I wanted  
her near enough her Grandmother, as  
I knew she would be summoned  
to see her before death. And I also  
wanted her near the Route by  
which I may have one chance in a  
thousand of saving her. Which I could  
not hope for even she so far off  
my Lia or St Mary. Please say  
to little Angela that I know her son  
to whom I would rather intrust mine  
than to her, but the above memory  
controlled me in my choice. After  
two years at Cincinnati if Lia I  
will have him in New York for  
another year, which will complete his  
16<sup>th</sup> year, after which I doubt if she will  
have me now to control her.
