I wrote you yesterday

repeat for certainty that
I want him to see the
Coffin disinterred, properly
boxed up, and brought
to me here at St Louis.

I would come myself
but am compelled at the
same time to go to Lancaster
Ohio, to bring the body of
my other son who is buried
there.

I expect to come up
on some future occasion
when I can more fully
express my sense of oblig-
ation for your kindness to
my wife & children. They
are all well, and send
you every possible expres-
sion of affection.
