favored by you or your Very Rev. General.

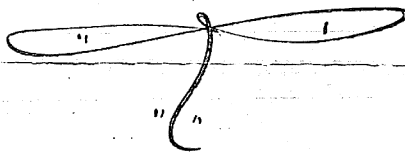
Hoping to receive an early reply and to be
