NUMBERING OF COURSES: Courses numbered below 100 are undergraduate courses. Courses between 100 and 200 are advanced undergraduate courses which may be taken for graduate credit with the permission of the Head of the Department. Courses above 200 are graduate courses.

The University reserves the right to cancel courses for which there is insufficient registration. Students planning to take courses in Engineering are advised to consult the Dean of the College of Engineering by April 14.
