1. RETURN THE PRELIMINARY FORM (Cut it off of the last page of this booklet)
2. If you are a "NEW" student or a "RETURN" student, the Director of the Summer Session will send you UPON RECEIPT of the PRELIMINARY INFORMATION FORM, a formal APPLICATION FORM which must be completed and returned to the Director of the Summer Session, University of Notre Dame, Notre Dame, Indiana.
3. AFTER you have completed the PRELIMINARY INFORMATION form and /or the APPLICATION FORM, your Departmental Advisor, Department Head or Undergraduate Dean will mail you TWO FORMS:
 - (a) "REQUEST TO REGISTER" form (This is a pre-punched tabulating card)
 - (b) "COURSE SELECTION" form (Three parts)

4. Read the instructions on each form; complete BOTH FORMS and MAIL BOTH FORMS TO YOUR ADVISOR. They must be postmarked no later than Thursday, May 10th, 1962.

DON'T SELECT COURSES FOR AUDIT UNTIL THE FIRST CLASS DAY AFTER FORMS ARE RETURNED TO ADVISOR FOR APPROVAL, COURSE SELECTIONS MAY NOT BE CHANGED UNTIL THE "DROP AND ADD" PERIOD AFTER you REPORT TO SCHOOL (see item 5 below)

5. You will receive from the Office of Student Accounts a "Statement of Account". Enclosed with the Statement will be an explanation of the procedure for paying your fees by mail and how to obtain "Class Entry Permits" on Monday, June 18, 1962. Fees should be paid by mail by June 5, 1962.
6. LATE REGISTRATION IS DEFINED as the filing of forms after May 10, 1962. Permission must be obtained in advance. There is a \$10.00 fee. NO EXCEPTIONS.

NUMBERING OF COURSES: Courses numbered below 100 are undergraduate courses. Courses between 100 and 200 are advanced undergraduate courses which may be taken for graduate credit with the permission of the Head of the Department. Courses above 200 are graduate courses.

The University reserves the right to cancel courses for which there is insufficient registration.
