FRESHMAN YEAR COURSES ARE NOT LISTED SEPARATELY. SEE THE DEPARTMENT OFFERING THE COURSES.
- IV. LATE REGISTRATION requires the permission of the dean of your college in advance. The fee is \$25.00. All approvals must be cleared thru Academic Affairs. The late registration fee is charged against continuing students who fail to report to Stepan Center on Mon. & Tues., Sept. 20 & 21, 1965.
- V. Failure to pay the \$50.00 Advance Enrollment Fee required of continuing undergraduate students will cause your advance registration schedule to be cancelled.
- VI. THE UNIVERSITY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CANCEL CLASSES OR CHANGE INSTRUCTORS. STUDENTS MAY BE SHIFTED FROM ONE SECTION TO ANOTHER BY DEPARTMENT HEADS IN ORDER TO BALANCE SECTIONS. A STUDENT MAY BE WITHDRAWN FROM A (✓) COURSE IF HE DOES NOT HAVE AN "AUTHORIZATION" CARD OR IF THE ADVISOR PLACED THE STUDENT IN A "BLOCK" OF CLASSES WHICH WERE NOT RESERVED FOR THE STUDENT'S COLLEGE OR ASSIGNED TO THE ADVISOR.

## STUDENT ADVANCE REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR FALL 1965-66

I. Advance Registration will take place between Monday, May 10 and Friday, May 21, 1965.

II. REGULATIONS FOR ADVISORS AND STUDENTS:

- (1) ALL UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS MUST HAVE TWO CLASSES IN THE AFTERNOON AND ONE ON SATURDAY OR OR VICE VERSA.
- (2) "Special" Schedule permits will not be issued for early registration in September.
- (3) Your advisor must approve your schedule. He is restricted to "blocks" of classes set aside for his use by the University Scheduling Committee and the course prerequisite in the catalogue.

THE ADVISOR CAN NOT:

- (a) Exempt you from the rules on Saturday or afternoon classes.
- (b) Schedule courses outside of the "block" reserved for his use.
- (c) Schedule you for checked (✓) courses unless you obtain the "authorization" cards before you consult him.
- (d) Permit you to take a course load which is less than or exceeds the course load specified by the college catalogue. Permission for overloads or part-time status must be approved by the dean of your college.

III. SCHEDULING PROCEDURE FOR ALL STUDENTS: Follow steps (A) (B) (C) (D) (E) (F) (G)

STEP (A) Check the date you are to report or make an appointment with your advisor.

GRADUATE STUDENTS - By appointment with the department head any time during the registration period.

LAW STUDENTS - See notices posted in the Law School.

CURRENT FRESHMEN - Report to the college of your intent according to the instructions of your college.

UPPERCLASSMEN WHO HAVE NOT SELECTED THEIR MAJORS - See Bulletin Boards in your respective colleges for hour, date and place of registration.

UPPERCLASSMEN WHO HAVE SELECTED THEIR MAJORS - Make appointments by writing your name opposite the hour and date when you and your advisor are free. Use the lists posted outside your department head's office. (Individual department heads may prescribe a different procedure. If they do so, you will be notified by professors in your class.)

STEP (B) (1) BE CERTAIN TO READ PAGE "B" SO YOU WILL UNDERSTAND THE COLLEGE RESERVATION, THE COURSE EXAMINATION AND THE (✓) CHECK MARKED COURSE COLUMNS.

(2) Obtain "Class Authorization" cards for check mark (✓) courses from the department offering the courses BEFORE you see your advisor. (Cards will be available beginning Friday, May 7, 1965.)

STEP (C) ON THE DATE YOU ARE DUE TO REGISTER, REPORT ABOUT 15 MINUTES BEFORE YOU EXPECT TO SEE YOUR ADVISOR TO THE ROOM DESIGNATED BELOW.

STEP (D) PRESENT YOUR "I.D." CARD AND OBTAIN:

- (1) Schedule Book
- (2) Registration Form - which is to be imprinted from the "I.D." card. (If you do not have an "I.D." card, report to Room 322, Administration Bldg. before you are due to register.)

STEP (E) PRESENT TO YOUR ADVISOR:

- (1) The Registration Form.
- (2) Any (✓) "Class Authorization" cards you obtained from the department head or the dean.

STEP (F) In consultation with your advisor, schedule your classes and complete the Registration Form. The advisor must approve the schedule after verifying that it conforms to Rule III below: ON THE FORM print the number of credits for EACH "Variable Credit" course approved.

STEP (G) Leave the form INTACT. Your advisor will return it to the dean.

DO NOT RETAIN ANY PART OF THE REGISTRATION FORM FOR ANY REASON!

IV. MON-TUES, SEPT 20, 21, 1965: ALL STUDENTS MUST REPORT TO STEPAN CENTER TO OBTAIN "CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION" WHICH SHOWS YOUR SCHEDULE--COMPLETE ENROLLMENT CARDS AND PAY FEES.

# EXPLANATION OF SCHEDULE BOOK CODES

## I. EXPLANATION OF THE "SUFFIX" (Sfx) IN THE COURSE NUMBER COLUMN OF THE SCHEDULE BOOK:

In the SUFFIX column the letter "D" denotes Demonstration; "FS" for Foreign Students; "H" for Honors; "I" for Innsbruck Program; "L" for Lab.; "M" means the class is primarily for Moreau Seminars; "N" denotes a Night Course; "R" for Research courses; and "T" for Tutorial.

## II. EXPLANATION OF THE CREDIT (Cre.) HOUR COLUMN OF THE SCHEDULE BOOK:

If the column is blank, the course is a "no grade" course. If the column has a "00" printed in it, the course is a "credit" course which is not included in the averages. (Music Organization courses--NEITHER THE CREDIT NOR THE GRADE IS INCLUDED IN THE AVERAGES.) If the letter "V" is printed in the column, MAKE CERTAIN THAT YOUR ADVISOR ASSIGNS CREDIT HOURS TO THE COURSE ON YOUR REGISTRATION FORM OR CLASS CARD. The credit for all other courses is listed and must agree with the catalogue description.

## III. EXPLANATION OF THE SEQUENCE NUMBER COLUMN (Course Seq. No.) OF THE SCHEDULE BOOK:

The course sequence number must be correct. Incorrect sequence numbers will cause assignment to the wrong course or section and time. PRINT ALL SIX DIGITS OF THE SEQUENCE NUMBER. The first digit of ALL service courses is "ZERO" and must be shown. The last two digits of each sequence number indicates the SECTION number and must be shown.

## IV. EXPLANATION OF THE ABBREVIATIONS IN THE "Hr.-Days" COLUMN OF THE SCHEDULE BOOK:

Classes normally begin on the half hour in the morning and ten minutes past the hour in the afternoon. Tuesday and Thursday classes which run for an hour and fifteen minutes will meet at the following times: An 8:00 A.M. to 9:15 A.M. class will be shown as 8TT10; a 9:30 A.M. to 10:45 A.M. class is shown as 9TT11; an 11:00 A.M. to 12:15 P.M. class will be shown as 10TT12. 1TT3 denotes a class which meets from 1:10 P.M. to 2:25 P.M.; a 2TT4 denotes a class meeting 2:30 P.M. to 3:45 P.M.; and 4TT6 denotes a class meeting 4:00 P.M. to 5:15 P.M.

## V. EXPLANATION OF THE FINAL "EXAM" CODE COLUMN IN THE SCHEDULE BOOK:

Check the Examination Code column for the letters "C" and "D" and "F". The "D" denotes upper-class departmental examinations, the "F" denotes Freshman Year departmentals and the "C" denotes courses in which the examination is to be given by section. It is the student's responsibility to avoid final examination conflicts and four examinations in one day.

## VI. EXPLANATION OF THE "CHECK MARK" IN THE CLASS CODE COLUMN OF THE SCHEDULE BOOK:

If the course you select has a check (✓) mark in the class code column, you must report to the department which offers the course and obtain a "class authorization" card BEFORE YOU SEE YOUR ADVISOR. Give the "class authorization" card to your advisor when you arrange your schedule. See the opposite page for the list of (✓) checked classes. You may obtain "class authorization" cards beginning Friday, May 7, 1965.

## VII. EXPLANATION OF THE "COLLEGE RESERVATION" (Col. Resv. & Sec.) COLUMN IN THE SCHEDULE BOOK:

- A. UPPERCLASSMEN: All courses are reserved by college except as noted in Item B below! THE DEAN OF THE COLLEGE AFFECTED MUST APPROVE ANY REQUESTS TO TAKE A CLASS WHICH IS AN EXCEPTION TO THE COLLEGE RESERVATION. Space in each class is reserved for students of the college designated in the RESERVATION COLUMN. The number of students permitted in each class is also indicated. Departmental advisors have been assigned portions of various sections for their students in order to assure equal access to the students in the various departments.

The college codes are AL--Arts and Letters; BA--Business Administration; EG--Engineering; FY--Freshman Year; GR--Graduate School; LW--Law School; SC--Science.

- B. "UN" in a course indicates it is open to two or more colleges of the university. The number of spaces reserved for each college is shown in the college column. The deans have assigned "blocks" to each department head so that equal access to the course is available to students within the college. If no spaces are reserved for a particular college, the course is open to all students.
- C. UPPERCLASSMEN MAY NOT TAKE CLASSES RESERVED FOR THE FRESHMAN YEAR EXCEPT AS NOTED IN THE COLLEGE RESERVATION COLUMN. THE DEAN OF THE FRESHMAN YEAR OF STUDIES OR HIS REPRESENTATIVE (NOT THE DEAN OF YOUR COLLEGE) MUST APPROVE ANY REQUESTS FROM UPPERCLASSMEN TO TAKE FRESHMAN YEAR COURSES. CERTAIN FRESHMAN YEAR COURSES ARE CLOSED TO UPPERCLASSMEN WITHOUT EXCEPTION.
- D. Classes in ROTC; Computer Science; Physical Education and Music Organization have not been "blocked" by college. Developmental Reading or Speech Clinic classes must have the permission of the department head.
- E. LAW COURSES are restricted to law students except for section "4" of Torts which is designated "UN" and requires an authorization (✓) card.
- F. GRADUATE COURSES are restricted to graduate students and qualified seniors except for "300's" series which are restricted to graduate students only. They will have the abbreviation "GR" in the college reservation column.
- G. All courses are subject to prerequisites shown in the catalogue.

SCHEDULE OF SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS

FALL 1965-66

- I. The last class day is Wednesday, January 19, 1966. Thursday and Friday, January 20 and 21 are designated as "STUDY DAYS". Examinations begin at 7:00 P.M., Friday evening, January 21.
- II. FINAL EXAMINATION REGULATIONS: Two hour finals must be given on the assigned examination dates. CHANGES IN THE HOUR, DATE OR PLACE OF THE EXAMINATION AS ASSIGNED BY ACADEMIC AFFAIRS ARE NOT PERMITTED. Professors with three or more sections may arrange for a "joint" examination.
- III. JANUARY GRADUATES: Names of eligible students will be provided to the faculty. These students take their final examinations at the regularly scheduled time. If a graduating student has a "B" average in the class, he may be exempt from the final examination AT THE DISCRETION OF THE PROFESSOR.
- IV. NIGHT CLASSES: Professors will appoint a suitable two hour period during one evening of the examination period. (Use the classroom assigned during the semester.)
- V. 75 or 90 MINUTE CLASSES: These are to be examined at the time which corresponds to the first portion of the class. (e.g. 9:30 TT 10:45 is examined at the 9:30 Tuesday time.) Classes which begin after a regularly schedule hour will follow the same rule. (e.g. 2:30 TT 3:45 will use the 2:10 Tuesday slot; 11:00 TT 12:15 will use the 10:30 Tuesday slot.)

ART HISTORY 19 and ENGLISH 11 WILL BE EXAMINED ON THE LAST CLASS DAY. ALL OTHER FRESHMEN COURSES ARE EXAMINED DEPARTMENTALLY ALTHOUGH PROFESSORS NEED NOT GIVE A UNIFORM DEPARTMENTAL EXAMINATION.

UPPERCLASS COURSES WHICH ARE AUTHORIZED DEPARTMENTALS ARE:

- (1) Engineering Science 26, 31, 33, 34 will be examined at 2:00-4:00 P.M. on Saturday, Jan. 22, 1966.  
(2) Mathematics 21 will be examined at 2:00-4:00 P.M. on Tuesday, January 25, 1966.
