STEP III. PROCEED TO THE "CHECK-OUT" TABLES:

**A. ALL NON-FRESHMEN:**

- Present all tab cards. Place cards in the order listed in Step II.
- EXCHANGE TAB CARDS A-B-C-D-E-F-G FOR YOUR "CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION". Sign the certificate, fold it and place it in the "I.D." card jacket.
- PROCEED TO STEP IV TO EXCHANGE CERTIFICATIONS.

**B. FRESHMEN ONLY:**

- Present all tab cards. Place them in the order listed in Step II.
- YOU WILL RECEIVE A "CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION" FOR THE TAB CARDS. RETAIN THE "FORM 100" THE "I.D." CARD AND ENVELOPE AND THE "CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION".
- PROCEED TO THE FRESHMAN YEAR TABLES FOR "I.D." PHOTO AND OBTAIN CLASS CARDS FOR EITHER PHYSICAL EDUCATION, OR ARMY, OR NAVY OR AIRFORCE ROTC.
- AFTER YOU OBTAIN CLASS CARDS, STOP AT THE "FORM 100" DESK AND GIVE THE CLERK THE "FORM 100" AND ALL CLASS CARDS ON WHICH YOU HAVE WRITTEN YOUR "I.D." NUMBER. SIGN THE "CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION", FOLD IT AND PLACE IT INTO THE "I.D." CARD JACKET.
- PROCEED TO STEP IV TO EXCHANGE CERTIFICATIONS IF YOU LIVE ON CAMPUS.

STEP IV. (A) FOREIGN STUDENTS (INCLUDING CANADIANS): STOP AT FOREIGN STUDENT TABLE AND COMPLETE SPECIAL FORMS.

(B) OFF-CAMPUS STUDENTS: STOP AT OFF-CAMPUS TABLE BEFORE EXITING AT EAST DOOR.

(C) ON-CAMPUS STUDENTS: STOP AT BOTH LAUNDRY AND DINING HALL TABLES -

- DINING HALL TABLES: Exchange board certification for Dining Hall Card.
- LAUNDRY-DRY CLEANING TABLES: Exchange laundry and dry cleaning certifications for laundry and/or dry cleaning books.

STEP V. EXIT:

UPPERCLASSMEN AND GRADUATE STUDENTS WHO MUST CHANGE OR COMPLETE THEIR SCHEDULES MUST REPORT TO O'SHAUGHNESSY HALL TO SEE THEIR ADVISORS IMMEDIATELY! USE SOUTH WEST DOOR.

# EXPLANATION OF CODES IN SCHEDULE BOOK AND ON THE "CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION"

## I. EXPLANATION OF THE "SUFFIX" (Sfx) IN THE COURSE NUMBER COLUMN OF THE SCHEDULE BOOK:

In the SUFFIX column the letter "D" denotes Demonstration; "FS" for Foreign Students; "H" for Honors; "I" for Innsbruck Program; "L" for Lab.; "M" means the class is primarily for Moreau Seminarists; "N" denotes a Night Course; "R" for Research courses; and "T" for Tutorial.

## II. IN THE COLLEGE RESERVATION COLUMN ON YOUR STUDENT SCHEDULE: "FY" MEANS THAT THE COURSE IS RESERVED FOR FRESHMEN: "AL" FOR STUDENTS IN THE COLLEGE OF ARTS AND LETTERS; "BA" FOR STUDENTS IN THE COLLEGE OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION; "LW" FOR STUDENTS IN THE SCHOOL OF LAW; "EG" FOR STUDENTS IN THE COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING; "SC" FOR STUDENTS IN THE COLLEGE OF SCIENCE; "UN" INDICATES THE COURSE IS OPEN TO ALL STUDENTS; "GR" INDICATES THAT THE DEPARTMENT HEAD'S PERMISSION IS REQUIRED TO TAKE THE COURSE.

## III. EXPLANATION OF THE CREDIT (Cre.) HOUR COLUMN OF THE SCHEDULE BOOK:

If the column is blank, the course is a "no grade" course. If the column has a "00" printed in it, the course is a "credit" course which is not included in the averages. (Music Organization courses-- NEITHER THE CREDIT NOR THE GRADE IS INCLUDED IN THE AVERAGES.) If the letter "V" is printed in the column, MAKE CERTAIN THAT YOUR ADVISOR ASSIGNS CREDIT HOURS TO THE COURSE ON YOUR REGISTRATION FORM OR CLASS CARD. The credit for all other courses is listed and must agree with the catalogue description.

## IV. EXPLANATION OF THE SEQUENCE NUMBER COLUMN (Course Seq. No.) OF THE SCHEDULE BOOK:

PRINT THE CORRECT NUMBER ON THE "FORM 100". Incorrect sequence numbers will cause assignment to the wrong course or section and time. PRINT ALL SIX DIGITS OF THE SEQUENCE NUMBER. The first digit of ALL service courses is "ZERO" and must be shown. The last two digits of each sequence number indicates the SECTION number and must be shown.

## V. EXPLANATION OF THE FINAL "EXAM" CODE COLUMN IN THE SCHEDULE BOOK:

Check the Examination Code column for the letters "C" and "D" and "F". The "D" denotes upperclass departmental examinations, the "F" denotes Freshman Year departmentals and the "C" denotes courses in which the examination is to be given by section. It is the student's responsibility to avoid final examination conflicts and four examinations in one day.

## VI. EXPLANATION OF THE ABBREVIATIONS IN THE "Hr.-Days" COLUMN OF THE SCHEDULE BOOK:

Classes normally begin on the half hour in the morning and ten minutes past the hour in the afternoon. 8:30 A.M. classes are shown as 8; 9:30 A.M. classes are shown as 9; etc. Tuesday and Thursday classes which exceed 50 minutes are shown as follows: An 8:00 A.M. to 9:15 A.M. class will be shown as 8TT10; an 9:30 A.M. to 10:45 A.M. class is shown as 9TT11; an 11:00 A.M. to 12:15 P.M. class will be shown as 10TT12. 1TT3 denotes a class which meets from 1:10 P.M. to 2:25 P.M.; a 2TT4 denotes a class meeting 2:30 P.M. to 3:45 P.M.; and 4TT6 denotes a class meeting 4:00 P.M. to 5:15 P.M. Where time is omitted, the professor will arrange hours with students. (Report to department office except for lab courses.)

## VII. EXPLANATION OF THE BUILDING AND ROOM CODE COLUMN IN THE SCHEDULE BOOK:

The name of the building corresponding to the building code is on the front page of this booklet and the bottom of the "Certificate of Registration". Room numbers are as shown except that in the library (bldg. 72) 100 means Room 1000; 120 means means Room 1200 and 130 means Room 1300. If a room is omitted, report to the office of the department offering the course. If a lab room is omitted, the location will be announced in class. Room numbers indicate where classes meet on first day of class.

## I. LATE REGISTRATION, PART-TIME STATUS AND SPECIAL STUDENT (without credit) PRIVILEGES:

THE DEAN OF THE COLLEGE MUST COMPLETE APPROPRIATE FORM DURING REGISTRATION. FOR LATE REGISTRATION, PERMISSION MUST BE OBTAINED IN ADVANCE. THE FEE IS \$25.00. ALL PERMISSIONS MUST BE APPROVED BY THE OFFICE OF ACADEMIC AFFAIRS.

## II. VETERANS: IF YOU USE YOUR "PL" ENTITLEMENT, REPORT TO STUDENTS ACCOUNTS OFFICE, GROUND FLOOR IN THE MAIN BLDG. BEFORE YOU REGISTER AT STEPAN CENTER. (ON SEPT. 20-21 REPORT DIRECTLY TO STEPAN.)

## III. ALL FOREIGN STUDENTS (including CANADIANS):

STOP AT THE FOREIGN STUDENT DESK IN STEPAN CENTER AND EITHER BEFORE OR AFTER REGISTRATION BRING YOUR PASSPORTS AND VISITOR'S PERMITS TO FATHER MCGRATH'S OFFICE, ROOM 219, MAIN BUILDING.

## IV. AUDITS: THESE MUST BE ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT OFFERING THE COURSE. THIS MAY BE DONE AT EITHER REGISTRATION TIME OR DURING THE FIRST WEEK OF SCHOOL AT THE DEPARTMENT OFFICE.

## V. "ADDS" and "DROPS": (After O'Shaughnessy closes and classes begin.)

GRADUATE STUDENTS: THESE WILL BE ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT HEAD OFFERING THE COURSE OR HIS REPRESENTATIVE AT THE DEPARTMENTAL OFFICE ON WEDNESDAY OR THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 22 and 23, 1965. "ADDS" AND "DROPS" MUST BE STAMPED BY THE ACADEMIC AFFAIRS OFFICE IN THE MAIN BUILDING.

UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS: THESE WILL BE ISSUED AT THE "DROP" AND "ADD" CENTER IN STEPAN CENTER ON WEDNESDAY OR THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 22 and 23, 1965 BETWEEN 8:30 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. FORMS MUST BE STAMPED!

# SCHEDULE OF SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS

FALL 1965-66

- I. The last class day is Wednesday, January 19, 1966. Thursday and Friday, January 20 and 21 are designated as "STUDY DAYS" until 6:00 P.M. Examinations begin at 6:00 P.M., Thursday evening, January 20, 1966.
- II. FINAL EXAMINATION REGULATIONS: Two hour finals must be given on the assigned examination dates. CHANGES IN THE HOUR, DATE OR PLACE OF THE EXAMINATION AS ASSIGNED BY ACADEMIC AFFAIRS ARE NOT PERMITTED. Professors with three or more sections may arrange for a "joint" examination.
- III. JANUARY GRADUATES: Names of eligible students will be provided to the faculty. These students take their final examinations at the regularly scheduled time. If a graduating student has a "B" average in the class, he may be exempt from the final examination AT THE DISCRETION OF THE PROFESSOR.
- IV. NIGHT CLASSES: Professors will appoint a suitable two hour period during one evening of the examination period. (Use the classroom assigned during the semester.)
- V. 75 or 90 MINUTE CLASSES: These are to be examined at the time which corresponds to the first portion of the class. (e.g. 9:30 TT 10:45 is examined at the 9:30 Tuesday time.) Classes which begin after a regularly schedule hour will follow the same rule. (e.g. 2:30 TT 3:45 will use the 2:10 Tuesday slot; 11:00 TT 12:15 will use the 10:30 Tuesday slot.)
