- II. The course sequence number is essential. Make certain it is correct. Print ALL digits in the number. The last two digits indicate the course section. ←
- III. Classes normally begin on the half hour in the morning and ten minutes past the hour in the afternoon. Tuesday and Thursday classes which run for an hour and fifteen will meet at the following times: a 8:00 A.M. to 9:15 A.M. class will be shown as 8TT10; a 9:30 A.M. to 10:45 A.M. class is shown as 9TT11; a 11:00 A.M. to 12:15 P.M. class will be shown as 10TT12. 1TT3 denotes a class which meets from 1:10 P.M. to 2:25 P.M.; a 2TT4 denotes a class meeting 2:30 P.M. to 3:45 P.M.; and 4TT6 denotes a class meeting 4:00 P.M. to 5:15 P.M.

#### DROPS

IF YOU DROP A COURSE, THE DEPARTMENTAL REPRESENTATIVE WILL STAMP THE FORM (AND REPLENISH HIS INVENTORY OF CLASS CARDS). ACADEMIC AFFAIRS WILL DELETE YOUR NAME FROM THE CLASS LIST.

STEP V. WHEN YOU HAVE OBTAINED CLASS CARDS FOR ADDS, OR HAD THE FORM STAMPED FOR DROPS, OR IF "CHECKOUT" YOU HAVE NOT MADE A CHANGE PROCEED TO THE NORTH END OF O'SHAUGHNESSY AND "CHECKOUT" AT EITHER ROOM 109 OR ROOM 110.

# SEMESTER EXAMINATION SCHEDULES

SPRING SEMESTER 1964-65

1. Academic Regulations 31: One hour examinations must be given on the assigned examination dates listed below. In addition, but not in place of it, part of the final examination may be given on one of the last two regular class meetings at the discretion of the instructor. If a department has received the approval of the Dean of the College and the Office of Academic Affairs for a Departmental Examination in a course at the beginning of the semester, a two hour examination may be given at night in lieu of two separate one hour examinations.
2. The period for each Departmental Examination is two hours. All other finals during the examination period are for one hour and are held in the regular classroom. Changes in the hour, date or place of examinations are not authorized.
3. In the Schedule Book the letters "D", or "C" or "F" appears beside each class. If the letter "C" appears, the course must be examined at the time set aside below for single hour examinations. If the letter "D" appears, check for the Non-Freshman Departmental Examination time. If the letter "F" appears, check for the Freshman Departmental Examination time.
4. Night Classes: The same regulations apply as for those of the day classes.
5. Students who expect to graduate will take their examinations at the same times as all other students. Graduating seniors who have a "B" in a course may be exempt from the examination in that course at the discretion of the instructor.
6. The last class day is Friday, May 28, 1965. Non-Freshmen exams begin Monday, May 31, 1965.
7. A student who misses an examination through his own fault will receive a "F". The instructor and the dean must both approve any request to take the examination at a later date before the student appears at the Office of Academic Affairs where a fee of \$15.00 will be charged in all cases.
8. CONFLICTS: UPPERCLASSMEN IN FRESHMEN COURSES MIGHT HAVE CONFLICTS, TAKE THE EXAMINATION WITH THE REGULAR CLASS AND ARRANGE WITH THE DEPARTMENT FOR A MAKEUP EXAMINATION IN THE FRESHMAN COURSE. CONFLICTS BETWEEN ENGR. SCI. AND MODERN LANGUAGE; TAKE THE ENGR. SCI. DEPARTMENTAL AND ARRANGE WITH THE MODERN LANGUAGE DEPARTMENT FOR A MAKE UP EXAMINATION.
