- IV. LATE REGISTRATION requires the permission of the dean of your college in advance. The fee is \$25.00. All approvals must be cleared thru Academic Affairs. The late registration fee is charged against the student beginning Wednesday, September 21, 1966 or the current student who failed to complete Steps I-II-III-IV of Advance Registration.
- V. ALL FOREIGN STUDENTS (INCLUDING CANADIANS) MUST STOP AT THE FOREIGN STUDENT DESK IN STEPAN CENTER AND EITHER BEFORE OR AFTER REGISTRATION BRING THEIR PASSPORTS AND VISITOR'S PERMITS TO FATHER MCGRATH'S OFFICE, ROOM 219, MAIN BUILDING.
- VI. THE UNIVERSITY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CANCEL CLASSES OR CHANGE INSTRUCTORS. STUDENTS MAY BE SHIFTED FROM ONE SECTION TO ANOTHER BY DEPARTMENT HEADS IN ORDER TO BALANCE SECTIONS. A STUDENT MAY BE WITHDRAWN FROM A (✓) COURSE IF HE DOES NOT HAVE AN "AUTHORIZATION" CARD OR IF THE ADVISOR PLACED THE STUDENT IN A "BLOCK" OR CLASSES WHICH WERE NOT RESERVED FOR THE STUDENT'S COLLEGE OR ASSIGNED TO THE ADVISOR.

STEP I. WRITING TABLES, "CHECK-IN" and FEE PAYMENT DESKS:

- PRESENT YOUR "I.D." CARD AT THE PROPER DESK ACCORDING TO THE REGISTRATION TIME SHOWN ON THE OPPOSITE PAGE. (DO NOT ATTEMPT TO REGISTER EARLY--YOUR PACKET WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE.) NON-FRESHMEN WHO DO NOT HAVE AN "I.D." CARD, MUST REPORT TO CAMERA #3 BEFORE THEY WILL BE REGISTERED.
- TAKE FROM THE TABLE AND COMPLETE A "STUDENT DIRECTORY CARD" AND A "STUDENT LOCATOR CARD" BEFORE YOU ARRIVE AT THE "CHECK-IN" DESK.

 - EXCHANGE THE YELLOW STRIPE STUDENT ENROLLMENT CARD AND, WHERE APPLICABLE, THE DEGREE APPLICATION CARD AND/OR THE QUESTIONNAIRE CARD FOR YOUR "CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION".
 - SIGN THE "CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION", FOLD IT AND CARRY IT IN YOUR "I.D." CARD JACKET. PRINT YOUR LOCAL ADDRESS ON THE FORM
- FRESHMEN ONLY:
 - PRESENT THE "I.D." CARD AND ENVELOPE AND HAVE YOUR "I.D." PHOTO TAKEN. AFTER PHOTO-GRAPH IS TAKEN YOU WILL BE GIVEN A TEMPORARY "I.D." CARD AND CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION.
 - TAKE THE "CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION" TO THE FRESHMAN YEAR TABLES. ALL FRESHMEN MUST OBTAIN CLASS CARDS FOR EITHER PHYSICAL EDUCATION OR ARMY OR NAVY OR AIRFORCE ROTC. (ALL OTHER CHANGES REQUIRE THE APPROVAL OF THE DEAN OF THE FRESHMAN YEAR.)
 - AFTER YOU OBTAIN CLASS CARDS, REPORT TO THE FRESHMAN YEAR "CHECK-OUT" DESKS:
 - PRESENT THE YELLOW STRIPE ENROLLMENT CARD AND THE CLASS CARD(S) YOU OBTAINED.
 - RETAIN THE "CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION", SIGN IT, FOLD IT AND CARRY IT IN YOUR "I.D." CARD JACKET. PRINT YOUR LOCAL ADDRESS ON THE FORM

REPORT IN THE SAME ORDER AS SHOWN FOR STEPAN CENTER. (THE INFORMATION DESK IS IN ROOM 121, O'SHAUGHNESSY.)

STEP I. REPORT TO YOUR DEAN OR ADVISOR. SEE THE ROOM LIST ON OPPOSITE PAGE FOR LOCATION OF DEANS AND ADVISORS. PRESENT TO YOUR ADVISOR THE "CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION" FORM YOU OBTAINED AT STEPAN CENTER.

STEP II. IF YOUR ADVISOR APPROVES YOUR REQUESTED CHANGE, HE WILL MAKE OUT EITHER AN "ADD" OR A "DROP" SLIP. YOU MUST TAKE THIS FORM TO THE DEPARTMENT WHICH OFFERS THE COURSE. (SEE THE ROOM LIST ON OPPOSITE PAGE FOR LOCATION OF DEPARTMENTS.)

"ADDS" IF YOU WISH TO "ADD" A COURSE, THE DEPARTMENTAL REPRESENTATIVE WILL COUNTERSIGN THE "ADD" SLIP PREPARED BY THE ADVISOR AND ASSIGN YOU TO A SECTION OF THE COURSE PROVIDED HE HAS SPACE IN THE CLASS. IF SPACE IS AVAILABLE, YOU WILL RECEIVE COPY "1" OF THE "ADD" SLIP TO PRESENT TO THE PROFESSOR. IF THE DEPARTMENT HEAD CAN NOT ASSIGN YOU TO A SECTION, YOU MUST RETURN TO YOUR ADVISOR AND THE "ADD" SLIP IS VOIDED.

"DROPS" IF YOU RECEIVE PERMISSION FROM YOUR ADVISOR TO "DROP" A COURSE, TAKE THE "DROP" SLIP TO THE DEPARTMENTAL OFFICE (WHICH OFFERS THE COURSE) FOR DELETION FROM THE CLASS LIST. HE WILL GIVE YOU COPY "1" TO RETAIN FOR YOUR RECORDS AND TO AVOID AN "FA" IN THE COURSE.

"CHANGE OF SECTIONS" THESE ARE PROCESSED ENTIRELY BY THE DEPARTMENT OFFERING THE COURSE. YOU DO NOT NEED APPROVAL OF YOUR ADVISOR. IF A CHANGE IS MADE, YOU WILL RECEIVE ONE COPY OF THE FORM TO PRESENT TO THE NEW PROFESSOR.

IF YOU INADVERTENTLY RETAIN COPY "2" OR "3" OF A FORM, PLEASE RETURN IT TO ACADEMIC AFFAIRS OR ROOM 121, O'SHAUGHNESSY IMMEDIATELY.

ON WEDNESDAY, THURSDAY AND FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 21, 22 AND 23, THE DEANS, ADVISORS AND DEPARTMENT HEADS WILL BE IN THEIR REGULAR OFFICES. THE LAST DAY FOR ALL CLASS CHANGES IS FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 23, 1966.

EXPLANATION OF CODES USED IN THE SCHEDULE BOOK AND ON THE "CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION"

I. THE "SUFFIX" (Sfx) IN THE COURSE NUMBER COLUMN:

In the SUFFIX column the letter "D" denotes Demonstration; "IS" for International Students; "H" for Honors; "I" for Innsbruck Program; "L" for Lab.; "M" means the class is primarily for Moreau Seminarists; "N" denotes a Night Course; "R" for Research Courses; and "T" for Tutorial. "EX" denotes courses open to Saint Mary's College students. "QA" indicates credit Quant. Anal. Lab. "F" for Anger Program.

II. THE CREDIT (Cre.) HOUR COLUMN:

If the column is blank, the course is a "No Grade" course. If the column has a "00" printed in it, the course is a "Credit" course which is not included in the averages. (Music Organization courses--NEITHER THE CREDIT NOR THE GRADE IS INCLUDED IN THE AVERAGES.) If the Letter "V" is printed in the column, MAKE CERTAIN THAT YOUR ADVISOR ASSIGNS CREDIT HOURS TO THE COURSE ON YOUR REGISTRATION FORM. The credit for all other courses is listed and must agree with the catalogue description.

III. THE SEQUENCE NUMBER COLUMN (Course Seq. No.) OF THE SCHEDULE BOOK:

Print the correct Course Sequence Number where it is requested on all forms. Incorrect Sequence Numbers will cause assignment to the wrong course or section and time. PRINT ALL SIX DIGITS OF THE SEQUENCE NUMBER. The first digit of ALL Service Courses is "ZERO" and must be shown. The last two digits of each Sequence Number indicates the SECTION number and must be shown.

IV. THE FINAL "EXAM" CODE COLUMN:

Check the Examination Code Column for the Letters "C" and "D" and "F". The "D" denotes upperclass departmental examinations, the "F" denotes Freshman Year departmentals and the "C" denotes courses in which the examination is to be given by section. It is the student's responsibility to avoid final examination conflicts and four examinations in one day.

V. THE ABBREVIATIONS IN THE "HR--DAYS" COLUMN:

Classes normally begin on the half hour in the morning and ten minutes past the hour in the afternoon. 8:30 A.M. classes are shown as 8; 9:30 A.M. classes are shown as 9; etc. Tuesday and Thursday classes which exceed 50 minutes are shown as follows: a 8:00 A.M. to 9:15 A.M. class will be shown as 8TT9; a 9:30 A.M. to 10:45 A.M. class is shown as 9TT11; an 11:00 A.M. to 12:15 P.M. class will be shown as 10TT12. 1TT3 denotes a class which meets from 1:10 P.M. to 2:25 P.M.; a 2TT4 denotes a class meeting 2:30 P.M. to 3:45 P.M.; and 4TT6 denotes a class meeting 4:00 P.M. to 5:15 P.M. Where the time is omitted, the professor will arrange hours with the students. Saint Mary's College courses begin at 8:10 A.M. in the morning and continue at ten minutes after the hour throughout the day. Classes that meet only twice a week at Saint Mary's College also begin at ten minutes after the hour.

VI. THE BUILDING AND ROOM CODE COLUMN:

The name of the building corresponding to the building code is on the front page of this booklet and the bottom of the "Certificate of Registration". Room numbers are as shown except that in the Library (Bldg. 72), 100 means Room 1000; 120 means Room 1200 and 130 means Room 1300. If a room is omitted, report to the office of the department offering the course. If a lab room is omitted, the location will be announced in class. Room numbers indicate where classes meet on first day of class.

VII. THE COLLEGE RESERVATION COLUMN:

In the College Reservation Column on your student schedule, "FY" means that the course is reserved for Freshmen; "AL" for students in the College of Arts and Letters; "BA" for students in the College of Business Administration; "LW" for students in the School of Law; "EG" for students in the College of Engineering; "SC" for students in the College of Science; "UN" indicates the course is open to all students; and "GR" indicates that the department head's permission is required to take the course. "QR" indicates a course usually reserved for Graduate Students.
