2. PERMISSION FOR LATE REGISTRATION MUST BE OBTAINED IN ADVANCE FROM THE DIRECTOR OF THE SUMMER SESSION AND WILL BE GRANTED UNDER SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES ONLY. THERE IS A FEE OF \$10.00 IN ALL CASES.
3. ALL STUDENTS MUST REPORT TO THE ADMINISTRATION BUILDING IN ORDER SHOWN ABOVE. DO NOT REPORT EARLIER — PACKETS WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE.
