# EXPLANATION OF CODING UTILIZED IN THIS SCHEDULE OF COURSES BOOKLET

(Please note column referencing appropriate to the Form 50.)

## I COURSE TITLE

An abbreviated descriptive title of each course. More detailed course descriptions are available in the respective college Bulletin of Information.

## II DEPARTMENTAL CODE (Column A on Form 50)

These are four or less letters which abbreviate the title of the department. The abbreviated code appears at the top of each new department in this Schedule of Courses booklet, along with the location of the respective departmental office as well as in the second column of the departmental course offerings.

## III THE COURSE NUMBER AND SUFFIX (Column B on Form 50)

Use the appropriate course number and suffix indicated in this Schedule of Courses booklet. If a course is divided into two or more parts (lab, drill, demonstration, etc.) or, if it is to be designated as "honors", use the appropriate suffix to designate this information. The standard suffixes used are "A", "B", and "C" for the same course when either the content, approach or the credit hours differ; "D" denotes a Drill or Demonstration course; "H" for Honors; "L" for Lab; "R" for Research courses; "S" for Studio courses which meet at actual clock hours indicated; "T" for Tutorial sections.

## IV THE "CRED" (CREDIT) HOUR (Column C on Form 50)

This column reflects the total number of credits to be awarded in a particular course. The credits assigned to all courses must agree with the catalog description. If the credit hour column is blank, the course is a "no grade" class which is usually a portion of a lecture, i.e. Lab and Drill, to which credit hours are assigned. If the column has "00" printed in it, the course is a graded course where the grade is usually "S" or "U" and it is not included in student averages. (Neither the credit hour nor the grade is included in the computation of averages for Music Organization courses.) If the letter "V" is printed in this column, it is a variable credit hour course and the advisor must assign, on the Form 50, credit hours to the course. These variable credit classes have section numbers in the 50's.

## V THE CLASS SEQUENCE NUMBER (Column D on Form 50)

A six digit number unique to each section of each course offered. Print all six digits of the class sequence number when requested. The last two digits of each Class Sequence Number indicates the "section" number and must be shown.

## VI THE ABBREVIATION IN THE "HR-DAYS" (Columns E and F on Form 50)

If the time is omitted, the instructor will arrange the class meeting hours with the students. Where hour-days are specified for a class, the following standard time and day designations are stipulated.
