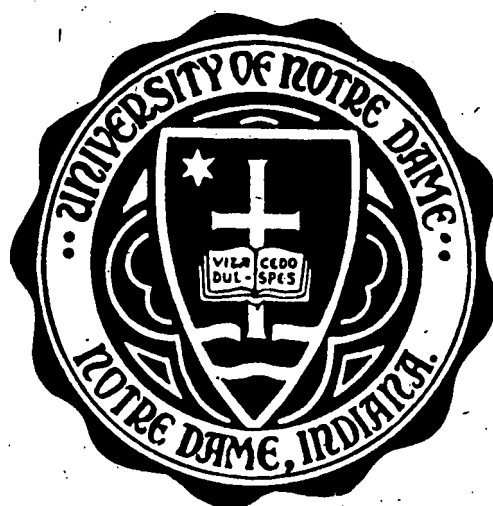

1. ALL STUDENTS WHO RECEIVED NOTIFICATION OF THEIR ACCEPTANCE MUST REPORT TO STEPAN CENTER. (SUPPLEMENTAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR REGISTRATION FOR SUMMER INSTITUTES, MINI-COURSES AND WORKSHOPS WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE BY THE APPROPRIATE PROGRAM DIRECTOR.) IF YOU WISH TO MAKE ANY CHANGES TO THE COURSE SCHEDULE SUBMITTED ON YOUR APPLICATION FORM YOU MUST OBTAIN THE APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENTAL ADVISOR BEFORE COMPLETING REGISTRATION. SEE LOCATION OF ADVISORS ON THE FRONT OF THIS BOOKLET AS WELL AS ITEM #5 BELOW.
2. ALL NEW OR RETURNING STUDENTS WHO DID NOT RECEIVE NOTIFICATION THAT ALL OF THEIR RECORDS (INCLUDING TRANSCRIPTS) WERE COMPLETELY PROCESSED, MUST REPORT TO THE OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE SUMMER SESSION (ROOM 312) ADMINISTRATION BUILDING (Golden Dome) BEFORE ATTEMPTING TO REGISTER.
3. PERMISSION FOR LATE REGISTRATION MUST BE OBTAINED IN ADVANCE FROM THE DIRECTOR OF THE SUMMER SESSION AND WILL BE GRANTED UNDER SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES ONLY.
4. AT THE STEPAN CENTER, IN EXCHANGE FOR THE COMPLETED ENROLLMENT CARD, YOU WILL RECEIVE A SUMMER SESSION "STUDENT CLASS SCHEDULE" WHICH IS TO BE USED AS AN IDENTIFICATION CARD. BUILDING CODE NUMBERS AND THE TIME SCHEDULE CODES USED IN SCHEDULE BOOKLET AND ON "STUDENT CLASS SCHEDULE" ARE EXPLAINED BELOW.
5. ANY ADDITIONAL "DROPS", "ADDS" OR "AUDITS" MAY BE PROCESSED THROUGH FRIDAY, JUNE 26, 1981, WHICH IS THE LAST DATE FOR CHANGES WITHOUT PENALTY. REPORT TO THE OFFICE OF THE DEPARTMENT CHAIRMAN WHICH OFFERS THE COURSE YOU WISH TO "DROP", "ADD" OR "AUDIT", TO OBTAIN PERMISSION. TAKE THE APPROVED FORM TO THE OFFICE OF STUDENTS' ACCOUNTS (102 ADMINISTRATION BUILDING) TO ADJUST YOUR ACCOUNT. YOU WILL THEN BE DIRECTED TO THE OFFICE OF THE REGISTRAR FOR FINAL PROCESSING OF THE CHANGE.
