IF YOU WISH TO MAKE ANY CHANGES TO THE COURSE SCHEDULE SUBMITTED ON YOUR APPLICATION FORM YOU MUST OBTAIN THE APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENTAL ADVISOR BEFORE COMPLETING REGISTRATION FOR YOUR COURSES.
2. ALL NEW OR RETURNING STUDENTS WHO DID NOT RECEIVE NOTIFICATION THAT ALL OF THEIR RECORDS (INCLUDING TRANSCRIPTS) WERE COMPLETELY PROCESSED, MUST REPORT TO THE OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE SUMMER SESSION ROOM 310 ADMINISTRATION BUILDING (Golden Dome) BEFORE ATTEMPTING TO ENROLL.
3. PERMISSION FOR LATE ENROLLMENT MUST BE OBTAINED IN ADVANCE FROM THE DIRECTOR OF THE SUMMER SESSION AND WILL BE GRANTED UNDER SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES ONLY.
