DROP AND ADD

Any additional "Drops", "Adds" or "Audits" may be processed through Friday, June 24, 1988, which is the last date for changes without penalty. Report to the office of the department chairman which offers the course you wish to "Drop", "Add" or "Audit", to obtain permission.

Take the approved form to the Office of Student Accounts (102 Administration Building) to adjust your account. You will then be directed to the Office of the Registrar for final processing of the change.

CONTINUING AND NEW STUDENTS

Your signed copy of the enrollment form and Summer Session "Student Class Schedule" will serve as your identification for the Summer Session.

TRANSCRIPT REQUESTS

All transcript requests must be made in writing (not by telephone) to the Registrar's Office. There is a charge of \$2.00 for each transcript. They are normally mailed, but can be picked up in the Registrar's Office, 2 to 3 days after receipt of the request.

Transcripts given directly to a student are stamped **ISSUED TO STUDENT**.

The University issues transcripts of academic work taken only at Notre Dame. Requests for transcripts of work taken at other institutions should be directed to those institutions

Requests for transcripts will not be honored if you are financially indebted to the University.

In general, most evaluative information such as courses completed, grades earned, etc., cannot be issued to an outside party unless the student has given the Registrar permission to release it to that specific party. The Registrar may, however, disclose directory information without the student's stated permission. This includes full name, dates of attendance, certification of current or previous enrollment, full or part-time status, college/major or level, and degree(s) received.
