HE IS THE AUTHOR OF ABOUT 20 NOTABLE BOOKS, AND HE INAUGURATED MANY MOVEMENTS IN CATHOLIC EDUCATION, NOTABLY THE PRIVATE ROOM SYSTEM WHICH DATES FROM THE BUILDING OF SORIN HALL IN 1889. EVERY NOTRE DAME STUDENT OWES A GREAT DEAL TO FATHER ZAHM AND EVERY STUDENT IS ASKED TO OFFER UP HOLY COMMUNION FOR HIS RECOVERY.
