Sorin Chapel Closed.

From noon today until Easter Sunday the Blessed Sacrament will be removed from the Sorin Chapel. This is in accordance with the rubrics of the Church for Holy Week. On Holy Thursday and Holy Saturday you may receive Holy Communion only during the one Mass, which is said in the church -- at 7:00 Thursday and 7:30 Saturday.

Get Your Sticker.

Students who have not made their Easter Duty may get stickers for their luggage at office of the Prefect of Religion. The sticker is a beautiful etching of an ostrich with his head in the ground. (Note - We said beautiful etching, not beautiful ostrich. Don't be so meticulous.)

Holy Week Services.

- Wednesday, 7:30 p.m. -- Tenebrae. This service, which is repeated on Thursday and Friday evenings at the same hour, is the public recitation of Matins and Lauds of the Divine Office for the next day. The music of the "Lamentations" is one of the most inspiring things in the whole of Catholic Liturgy.
- Thursday, 7:00 a.m. -- Mass and Holy Communion in the church (only). This Mass is followed by the procession of the Blessed Sacrament to the repository, where a Host consecrated during the Mass is reserved for the service of the next day, when there is no consecration. The Blessed Sacrament is then adored all day and all night.
- Friday, 8:00 a.m. -- Mass of the Presanctified, followed by the Adoration of the Cross.
3:00 p.m. -- Way of the Cross.
- Saturday, 7:30 a.m. -- Mass, with Holy Communion. Before the Mass, beginning at 6:00, the Easter Water and Candle, etc., are blessed.
- Sunday, 6:00, 8:00, and 10:30 -- The Masses are the parish Masses, the first two in the Basement chapel, the other two in the church.
