TOMORROW IS THE FIRST FRIDAY OF MAY

1. Offer *tomorrow's whole Mass* and your Holy Communion in honor of the Sacred Heart. (There was "no First Friday" in April. But tomorrow you may start a new string of nine.)
2. Make tomorrow the first day of your Novena for Mother. (Your spiritual bouquet card was slipped under your door this afternoon.)
3. To the few it concerns: Fulfil tomorrow your 1939 Easter Duty. * * * Sin is the greatest burden in life: greater than debt, greater than celibacy, greater even than the burden of death. But have no fear of the meek and humble Christ. He will refresh you. And you shall find rest to your souls. Christ says: *Venite ad Me, omnes* (see engraving on pedestal; also Matt. XI, 28). *Come to Me, all . . . and I will refresh you.*
