LATE FACILITIES RESUME NEXT MONDAY MORNING.

As the rubrics do not permit the use of the hall chapels during the last three days of Holy Week, services will be held ONLY in Sacred Heart Church Thursday, Friday and Saturday. On these three days HOLY COMMUNION will not be distributed outside of Mass except, as noted below, on Holy Thursday between 6:00 and 7:00 A.M.

DILLON CHAPEL OPEN MONDAY.

Beginning Monday Holy Communion will again be distributed outside of Mass, but only in Dillon. Late facilities in Cavanaugh and Howard will resume Wednesday.

Monday and Tuesday Communions in Dillon ONLY UP TILL 10:00 O'CLOCK.

Tenebrae (Matins and Lauds chanted for the following day...at 7:30 PM Wednesday, Thursday and Friday evenings.)
Mass of the Pre-Sanctified.... Good Friday Morning at 8:00.
Way of the Cross.... Good Friday afternoon at 3:00; followed by Benediction with the Relic of the True Cross. (ALL STUDENTS REMAINING ON CAMPUS ARE REQUIRED TO ASSIST AT THIS EXERCISE).
Nocturnal Adoration.... Watch is kept before the Blessed Sacrament reserved in the Altar of Repository from the Mass of Holy Thursday until the service of Good Friday morning.
