LATE FACILITIES RESUME MONDAY MORNING.

As the rubrics do not permit the use of the hall chapels during the last three days of Holy Week, services will be held ONLY in Sacred Heart Church Thursday, Friday and Saturday. On these three days HOLY COMMUNION will not be distributed outside of Mass except, as noted below, on Holy Thursday between 6:00 and 7:00 A.M.

DILLON CHAPEL OPEN HOLIDAY.

Beginning Monday Holy Communion will again be distributed outside of Mass, but only in Dillon. Late facilities in Gassman Hall and Board will resume Wednesday.

Nocturnal Adoration.... Watch is kept before the Blessed sacrament reserved in the altar of repository from the case of Holy Thursday until the service of Good Friday evening.
