The Test Of Your Love

Sunday, Monday and Tuesday are three days set aside for special devotion to Our Lord who is with us in the Blessed Sacrament. This period is commonly called the Forty Hours Devotion. The presence of Christ with us is one of the supreme proofs of His love for us. If you love Christ and His real presence you will return that love by concrete devotion to Him in the Eucharist on our altars. This is a test of your love of the Eucharistic Christ. Your love is cold if it does not express itself in assistance at Mass, reception of Holy Communion and prayer before the enthroned Christ in the Church during Forty Hours.

The 10:00 Mass will be a Mass of Exposition.
The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for adoration all day,

A very short prayer after Holy Communion followed by breakfast is not reverence. Give at least fifteen minutes to your preparation and Thanksgiving.
