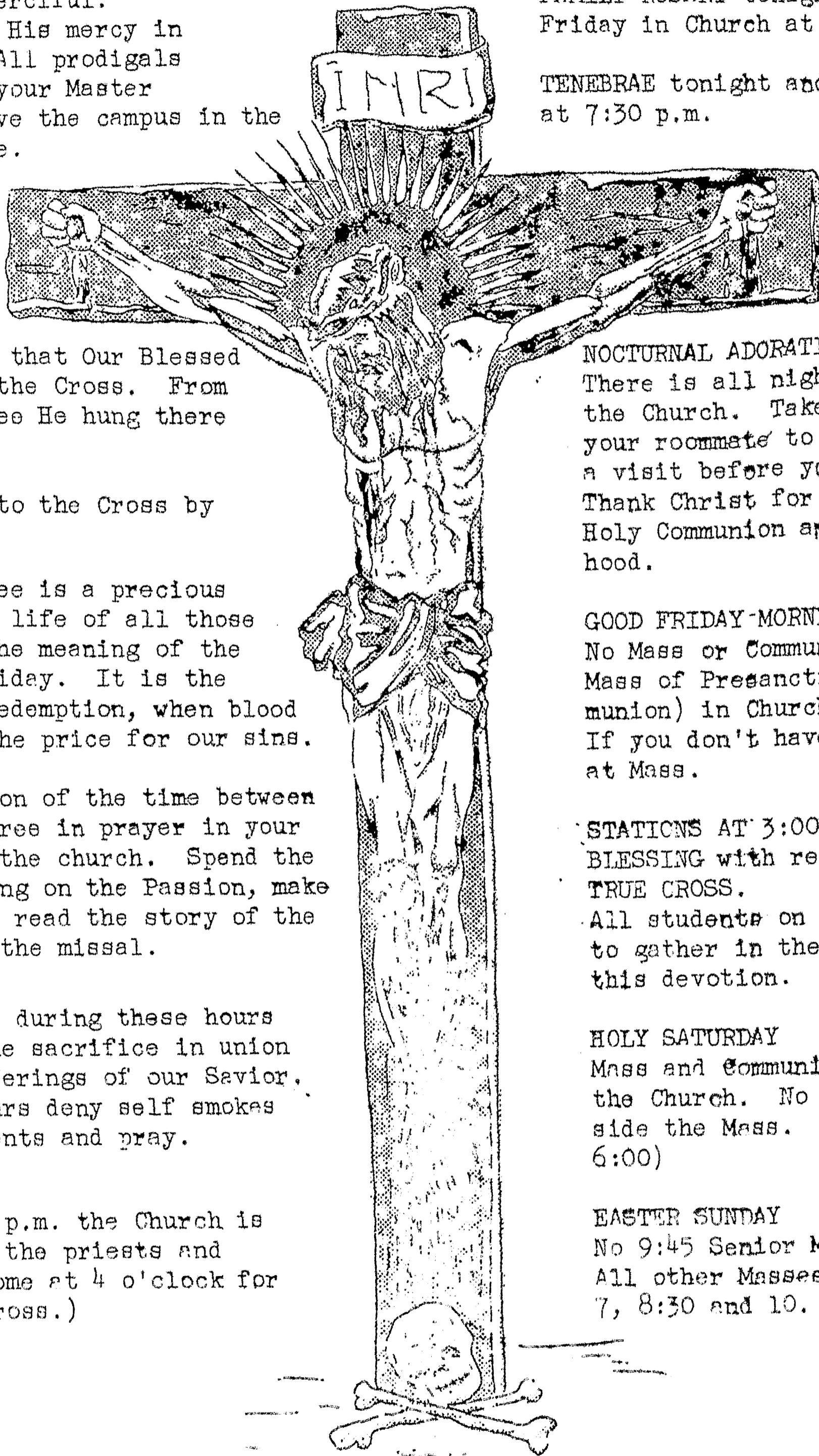


Our Lord is merciful.

Twelve to three is a precious  
period in the life of all those  
who realize the meaning of the  
First Good Friday. It is the  
hour of our Redemption, when blood  
was paid as the price for our sins.

Spend a portion of the time between  
twelve and three in prayer in your  
chapel or in the church. Spend the  
time reflecting on the Passion, make  
the Stations, read the story of the  
passion from the missal.

Deny yourself during these hours  
and accept the sacrifice in union  
with the sufferings of our Savior.  
For three hours deny self smokes  
and refreshments and pray.

(From 2 to 3 p.m. the Church is  
reserved for the priests and  
brothers. Come at 4 o'clock for  
the Way of Cross.)

NOCTURNAL ADORATION (tonight)  
There is all night Adoration in  
the Church. Take a walk with  
your roommate to the Church for  
a visit before you retire.  
Thank Christ for the Mass,  
Holy Communion and the Priest-  
hood.

GOOD FRIDAY-MORNING  
No Mass or Communion in halls.  
Mass of Preconsecrated (no Com-  
munion) in Church at 8:00.  
If you don't have class, assist  
at Mass.

STATIONS AT 3:00 p.m. and  
BLESSING with relic of  
TRUE CROSS.  
All students on the campus are  
to gather in the Church for  
this devotion.

HOLY SATURDAY  
Mass and Communion at 7:30 in  
the Church. No Communion out-  
side the Mass. (Blessings at  
6:00)

EASTER SUNDAY  
No 9:45 Senior Mass.  
All other Masses as usual: 6,  
7, 8:30 and 10.
