The only time one must go to confession before receiving Communion is when a mortal sin has been committed after the last confession. The conditions for the reception of Holy Communion are: 1) The state of grace; and 2) a good intention. As long as you are in the state of grace you need not receive the Sacrament of Penance. And don't forget, it is possible to remain in grace by avoiding the occasion of sin and by prayer and the use of the Sacraments.
