Starvation Ahead.

800 million people in Europe are going hungry. On April 13, the food ration of the American Zone in Germany was reduced to 1275 calories a day. At that time, medical and food authorities declared that such a reduction would make Germany the greatest study in mass starvation in history.

Each Notre Dame student is asked to give a money-offering, the equivalent of a square meal for a starving boy or girl.

Fifty cents, a half-buck, four bits, is that asking too much of you? Not at all when you consider the good that your offering will do. Freeze a half-dollar right now. Tonight or tomorrow a member of the Food Committee will stop at your room for your offering.

Don't give merely a slice of bread when you can afford to give a whole loaf. Don't give a glass of milk when you can give a whole quart. Dig deep into your jeans. Remember that you are giving to help one of Christ's little ones, and that it will come back to you as a blessing in some other form.
