Changes Have Been Made.

Father Craddick, Prefect of Religion, has moved his office to Dillon Hall. The old office in the tower room of Sorin is closed permanently. The new office is on the first floor of Dillon, a few feet from the chapel door, room 117. You will find Father in all morning until noon, and all evening after 7:30 P.M.

Father Simonitsch, former Assistant Prefect of Religion, has been assigned to new work. He is now Acting Head of the Department of Religion. He has moved to the Prefect's room on the second floor of Cavanaugh Hall.

Father Edmund Murray succeeds Father Simonitsch as Assistant Prefect of Religion. During the war Father Murray served as chaplain in the 104th Infantry Division. Last semester he was Prefect in Howard Hall. His office is in Cavanaugh Hall, room 107, where the Prefect of Religion has always been located. You can't miss the office; it's just outside the chapel door.

The confession and Communion buzzer moved with Father Craddick from Sorin to Dillon Hall. Two buzzes bring him to the confessional and one to the altar to distribute Holy Communion. Holy Communion is distributed until 12 noon in Dillon and until 9:30 A.M. in Cavanaugh.
