THE LEGION OF DECENCY PLEDGE...

In the Name of the Father and of the
Son and of the Holy Ghost. Amen.

crime or criminals.

I PROMISE to do all that I can to
strengthen public opinion against the
production of indecent and immoral
films, and to unite with all who protect
against them.

I ACKNOWLEDGE my obligation to form a
right conscience about pictures that are
dangerous to my moral life. As a member
of the Legion of Decency, I pledge myself
to remain away from them. I promise,
further, to stay away altogether from
places of amusement which show them as
a matter of policy.

The Vigil Of Christmas.

In virtue of a dispensation granted by our Bishop, the students, faculty and employees are not bound by the law of fast and abstinence on the Ember Days which fall on Wednesday, Friday and Saturday of this week.

This special dispensation does not hold on December 24, the vigil of Christmas. On this day you must follow the regulations of the diocese in which you are staying. Abstain from meat, unless you know definitely that the bishop has granted a dispensation.

It is most fitting that you abstain from food and drink for four hours from the time of Communion at Midnight Mass. If you think Holy Communion will be distributed about one o'clock, then start your fast a nine o'clock.
