Let the word of true encouragement be said:

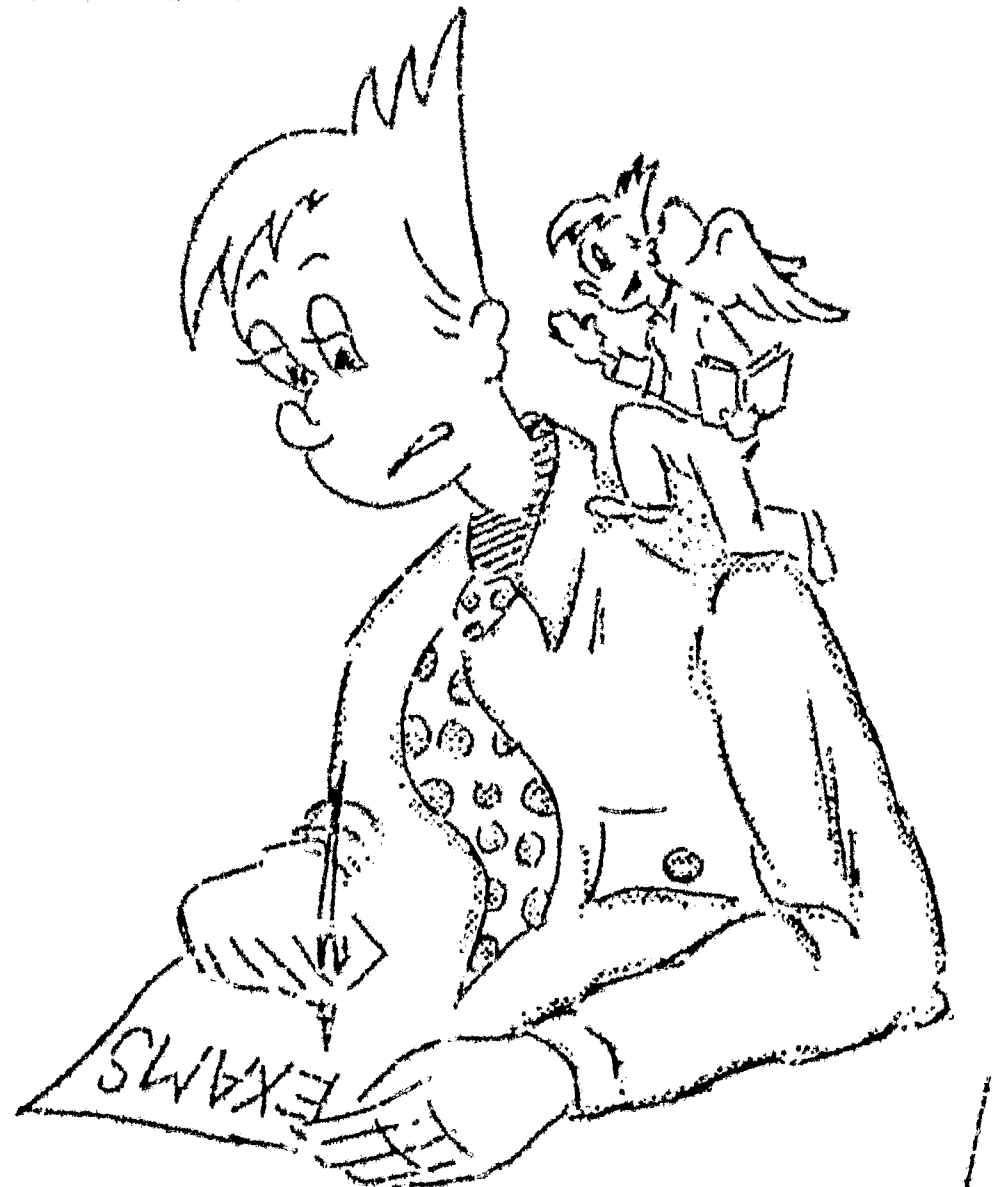
Do not wait till life is over
