Holy Week News.

The rubrics do not permit the use of the hall chapels during the last three days of Holy Week. On Thursday, Friday and Saturday, the services will be held only in the main church. Holy Communion will not be distributed outside of Mass. Note below the hours of services. Holy Communion is not distributed at all on Good Friday except to the dying.

Holy Week Services.

Holy Thursday: Solemn High Mass at 7:00 A.M.

Good Friday: Solemn Mass of the Presanctified at 8:00 A.M.

Holy Saturday: Services begin at 6:00 A.M.; the Solemn High Mass at 7:30 A.M.

Tenebrae: Matins and Lauds (Divine Office) for the following day are sung at 7:30 on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday evenings.

Way of the Cross: Friday at 3:00 P.M. followed by Benediction with the relic of the True Cross.

Nocturnal Adoration: Watch is kept before the Blessed Sacrament from the Mass of Holy Thursday until the Mass of the Presanctified, Good Friday morning.

Basement Chapel: 5:00 and 6:00 A.M.

Sacred Heart Church: 8:00....10:00....11:00 A.M.

Easter Monday and Tuesday: 7:20 A.M. Mass in Dillon chapel.
